- Flat tire blow-out caused by large piece of wood
- Chlorine pump maintenance and replacement of pumping tube
- Well Site vegetation removed. Booster Station + Tank Sites vegetation removal is in progress
- Dog Tags are to be placed on Fire Hydrants during the month/s of September & October
- Inventory on small parts and tools with labels is in progress
- Generator filters have been replaced and fuel replenished. Generator is expected to be placed back in service by the end of August.
